

Brooklyn Park Traveling Basketball 2010-2011 Registration Form



Eligibility: Players must reside within the Park Center High School attendance area and provide proof of address; driver license, utility bill, etc. All players will have to provide a copy of their 1st quarter mid term report for grade eligibility and grade verification before being allowed to participate in games. Players will also have to provide 1st quarter final report card grades to maintain eligibility. Additional information regarding academic eligibility is available at www.bphoops.org

Costs of program:

- 4th and 5th grade costs \$120.00 and will participate in 8 tournaments. Additional tournaments may be added to the schedule at the discretion & cost to the coaches and parents. You will need to provide 2 checks; one for \$85.00 and another for \$35.00, the 2nd check will be cashed if your child makes a team, shredded if they do not.
- 6th-8th grade cost \$200.00 and teams will play 10 or 11 weekend tournaments. You will need to provide 2 checks; one for \$120.00 and another for \$80.00, the 2nd check will be cashed if your child makes a team, shredded if they do not.
- Scholarships are available during walk-up registrations, families must provide copy of free and reduced lunch form from school district to be considered, funds are limited and given on first come first serve basis.
- A \$75.00 check deposit is required prior to issuing player uniforms. This check is not cashed unless the uniform is lost or damaged at the end of season.
- A \$150.00 volunteer check is required for each player at the start of the season. The check will not be cashed unless a family does not fulfill their volunteer hours during our tournament January 7-9th 2011. Each family will be required to fulfill up to 8 hours per player in the league during that weekend.

Try-outs: All registered players will participate in 2 – 90 minute tryouts during the week of September 27th. We will form up to 2 teams per grade if we have identified a coach for each team. Teams will have 9 or 10 players; those players that do not make a traveling team will have their registration form and payment transferred to the BPAA League. Tryout results will be posted on our website www.bphoops.org
